Safety/Security for The Academy of Moore County (TAMC)

In light of the many school incidents around the country, we (The Board of Directors, the School Administration and our Teachers) want to assure you that we are well prepared to meet any situations that may arise.

Over the years, we have taken steps to make sure our children, staff and parents will be as safe as possible when on campus. We have installed security cameras; we have provided lock-down devices for the classrooms; we have trained our teachers/staff in the steps to take if we have an incident; and we have developed a Master Security Plan for TAMC and will be constantly updating it as situations evolve. Many of the steps we have taken are not visible, and that is on purpose- we do not want to broadcast all that we have done.

Another safety measure is the installment of doors in the vestibule of both buildings. The purpose is to prevent direct entry into the school from the main office. All people coming to the school will have to go into the front office, sign in, obtain a Visitors Badge and then be buzzed into the main part of the school.

We also have a TAMC Safety/Security Committee. This group works closely with Moore County Sheriff's Office, Aberdeen Police Department, and Aberdeen Fire and Rescue Department to conduct Threat and Vulnerability Assessments of our campus and to conduct training drills. Please rest assured that we have the safety and security of our students, faculty/staff and parents foremost in our minds.

As always, no one person has all the answers. Safety and Security is everyone's responsibility. Together, we will provide the best atmosphere for our students to learn in.
